1. Proposals and Drafts for AGM 2020

We did not receive any proposal from any NMA on time (no later than eight weeks prior to the General Meeting). So the delivered proposals are all provided by the IISHF Presidium.

According to §11.7 IISHF Constitution these proposals to IISHF Regulations can only be altered by the applicant by providing the alteration before the start of the General Meeting with full new wording by email to IISHF Presidium and to all National Member Associations taking part at the General Meeting. During a General Meeting new proposals for Changes to the IISHF Regulations can only be put to a vote if all National Member Associations being present at the General Meeting unanimously agree.

2. Number of teams to be reported to IISHF.

We kindly remind all National Member Associations (NMAs) that the deadline to send us in reference to article 11.11 and 11.12 IISHF Constitution was until **15.01.2020** to IISHF headquarters (office@iishf.com):

- **How many inline skater hockey teams shall be registered in that country for the current year**
- **A detailed team list for all age groups with the name of all registered clubs and teams for the current year.**

If no report and/or no detailed team list has been given until 15.01.2020 the relevant number of teams shall be based on the previous year membership. For the

sake of complete information we also refer to article 11.11 IISHF Constitution that each Member Country (NMA) shall be entitled at General Meetings to:

- For Members with 49 teams or less registered 1 Vote
- For Members with 50 to 99 teams registered 2 Votes
- For Members with 100 or more teams registered 3 Votes

For those countries that have not yet reported their number of teams to IISHF please do so asap and if you don't have yet a complete overview of the number of teams for the season 2020 please use the numbers from the previous year membership.

3. IISHF Livestreaming Payment for 2019.

The payment for Livestreaming provided at IISHF Title Events in 2019 has now been completed by IISHF. The request for payment in reference to the various package level was in total 3.123,96 EURO but since the budget for livestreaming in 2019 was fixed by the NMA's at the AGM 2019 to 2.000 EURO then the payment has been regulated accordingly. Attached please find an overview over the payment made for 2019. IISHF appreciate very much the support given in 2019 to the livestreaming from IISHF Title Events.

4. No IISHF U19 European Championships 2020

The IISHF Presidium has decided that the IISHF U19 European Championships 2020 will not take place as there has been not been any positive reaction in regards to the call for action as given in the IISHF Communication Letter 2019-24 of 26th of December 2019.

Due to the IISHF Regulations in order for the European Championships to take place a minimum participation of 4 teams is required.

5. IISHF European Cup Title Events 2020 – final selection updated

Attached please find updated selection and ranking of the teams for the IISHF Men European Cups 2020. The following corrections have been made: The

Russian team for the Men Challenge Cup will be Hermes from Moscow and a correction of the spelling of the team from Ukraine in that event the team name is Telbin Riders. The Swiss team taking the vacant 12th spot for the Men European Cup will be IHC Malcantone. The ranking of teams has been done according to §18.5 Regulations (2019 version).

6. Friday Evening games for selected European Cup Title Events 2020

For a number of IISHF European Cup Title Events 2020 listed below (except Men European Cup - which is a 3 days event) there is an option for teams to play games on the Opening Night. It's not mandatory to play games Friday however if we can play 2 games Friday evening then the length of all group games for a 10 team Title event can then be extended from 2x10 minutes to 2x12 minutes.

We need to get response delivered from the participating teams for the mentioned IISHF Title Events. **The response should be delivered by the NMA's.** When responding the participating teams should reply if they are willing to play games on Friday (Yes or No) and if they are willing to play how early they would be able to play.

- **U13 European Cup hosted by Crefelder SC in Krefeld (Germany) on 12-14 June 2020.** This event is scheduled for 10 teams as a 2 days event for games Saturday and Sunday. However please note that the Managers Meeting (time to be announced) and Opening Ceremony (time to be announced) will take place Friday late afternoon/evening and this is mandatory for all teams. Practice sessions available Friday afternoon and it's possible for teams to play games Friday evening on an optional basis (not mandatory).
- **Men Challenge Cup hosted by SHC Rockets Essen in Essen (Germany) on 19-21 June 2020.** This event is scheduled for 10 teams as a 2 day event for games Saturday and Sunday. However please note that the Managers Meeting (time to be announced) and Opening Ceremony (time to be announced) will take place Friday late afternoon/evening and this is mandatory for all teams. Practice sessions available Friday afternoon and

it's possible for teams to play games Friday evening on an optional basis (not mandatory).

- **U16 European Cup hosted by Crash Eagles Kaarst in Karst (Germany) on 26-28 June 2020.** This event is scheduled for 10 teams as a 2 day event for games Saturday and Sunday. However please note that the Managers Meeting (time to be announced) and Opening Ceremony (taking place at 7 PM) will take place Friday late afternoon/evening and this is mandatory for all teams. No practice sessions available Friday afternoon. It's possible for teams to play games Friday evening on an optional basis (not mandatory).
- **U19 European Cup hosted by SHC Rossemaison in Rossemaison (Switzerland) on 3-5 July 2020.** This event is scheduled for 10 teams as a 2 day event for games Saturday and Sunday. However please note that the Managers Meeting (expected 5-6 PM) and Opening Ceremony (expected 6-7 PM) will take place Friday late afternoon/evening and this is mandatory for all teams. Practice sessions available Friday afternoon from 2-4 PM and it's possible for teams to play games Friday evening on an optional basis (not mandatory) from 7.30-10.00 PM.

Deadline for responding to the above request is set to 3 weeks so a final reply has to be sent to office@iishf.com no later than Sunday 9th February 2020.

7. IISHF Veterans Invitation Cup B-Event 2020

Gentofte Rollerskating Club will host a B-Event the IISHF Veterans Invitation Cup on 22nd-23rd August 2020 in Copenhagen, Denmark since there will not be any official IISHF Veterans Cup as a Title Event in 2020. All NMA's are welcome to inform their Veterans teams about this opportunity to compete internationally.

8. Temporary Membership for Lebanon

The IISHF presidium has approved temporary membership for the [Lebanese Roller Hockey Federation](http://www.hockeylebanon.com) (LRHF) (<https://www.hockeylebanon.com>). Please note that approval of membership as a new member of IISHF needs to be confirmed by the

Council of Members at the next IISHF General Meeting, which takes place in Moscow, Russia from 29.02.2020 to 01.03.2020.
